How to Get to Prague

Prague has one airport - Václav Havel airport well connected to other European cities.

There are also many bus and train connections, especially from Poland and Slovenia. We recommend checking Flixbus and Regiojet routes for buses and Czech Rails and Regiojet for trains. Travel is funded from the project, contact your sending organisation about booking it.

Accommodation
